## Orientation

Prior to the first week of class, new students attend the Center for Programs in Education orientation on the Seattle campus. Registration, e-mail accounts and student services information are covered, in addition to specific sessions designed for each education program.

## Courses

For specific examples of the course curriculum, please see the program fact sheet, available from the Admissions Office. For certification preparation only option, students must complete 62 quarter credits. For the combined preparation and M.A. in Education option, students must complete 74 quarter credits.

## Field Experiences

Before student teaching, students will be required to participate in field experiences in school classrooms during the day. These experiences are set up by the field placement coordinator in conjunction with the faculty. Two full weeks are required during the second quarter and three full weeks are required during the following quarters, in addition to evening classes.

## Student Teaching

Students complete a student teaching internship in the last quarter. Antioch cannot promise to accommodate your school of preference, the field placement coordinator will make every attempt to do so. Student teaching generally takes 10-12 weeks to complete.
