



Antioch University Seattle Library Using OhioLINK

1. Enter address: <http://www.ohiolink.edu>
2. After reaching the “Institution Selection Form” online, select **Antioch College**.
3. In 1st box, enter your **name**- last name, space, 1st name- (e.g., Doe John)
4. In 2nd box, enter “**anse**” then your **student number** (e.g., anse0012345) Click **Submit**

SEARCHING FOR JOURNAL ARTICLES

1. Go to www.ohiolink.edu
2. Under “Explore OhioLINK Databases” on the left, click on **By Name**.
3. Click on the first alphabetical letter of the **database** (e.g. A for Academic Search Premier).
4. Select desired **database**.
5. On the Search form, enter keywords to help you find articles on your topic and click **Submit Search**.
6. Click on the title of an article that you are interested in – if full- text is available, follow links to open the article. (Ask for help from **library staff** if necessary.)
7. If full text is not available, note the **article title, journal title, year, volume and issue**. See the **library staff** to get help on alternate ways of finding this article.
